

LAWCO Annual Hydrant Flushing in Iberia Parish Service Areas

Louisiana Water Company (LAWCO) in New Iberia will be performing our annual hydrant flushing beginning Sunday, April 17th, 2026. We will flush hydrants in the system over the course of a 6 - 8-week period with flushing operations occurring 24 hours per day - seven (7) days per week - until complete. Hydrant flushing will occur in our entire Iberia Parish service area; including, the City of New Iberia, Village of Loreauville, Lydia area, Port of Iberia area, Avery Island area, Rynella area and the Acadiana Regional Airport area.

During hydrant flushing, residents and businesses may experience a temporary drop in water pressure while we are flushing a fire hydrant in the area and cloudy or “milky” water which is caused by undissolved oxygen in the water that will dissipate within a few minutes. These conditions do not affect the quality or safety of the water, only appearance. The water is safe for all domestic purposes.

We encourage the traveling public to drive carefully around and near any of our maintenance personnel, equipment and any open hydrant flushing water and ask parents to keep children away from open hydrants and our maintenance crews performing such work.
